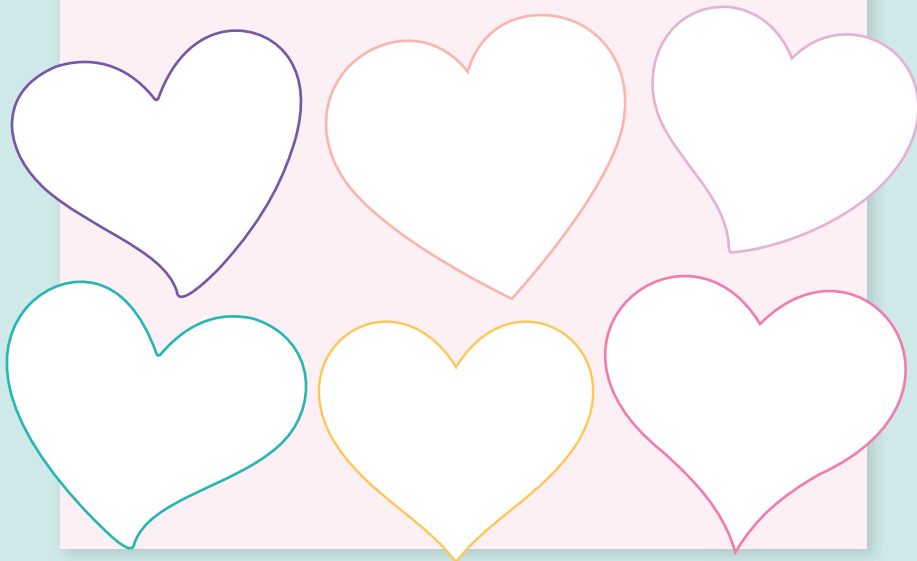

Week one day 4

GOD MADE THE HUMAN BODY TO HAVE AN AUTOMATIC THERMOSTAT for our heating and cooling systems, keeping our body temperature at about 98.6°F. God made us so intricately, even with the ability to maintain our body's correct temperature! So, when things are off and we're sick, our body temperature goes higher—it's fighting off germs. And then when we're better, our bodies return to our normal temperature.

Just like God created our body to fight off bad things, He also gave us wisdom to stay away from things that are harmful to us.

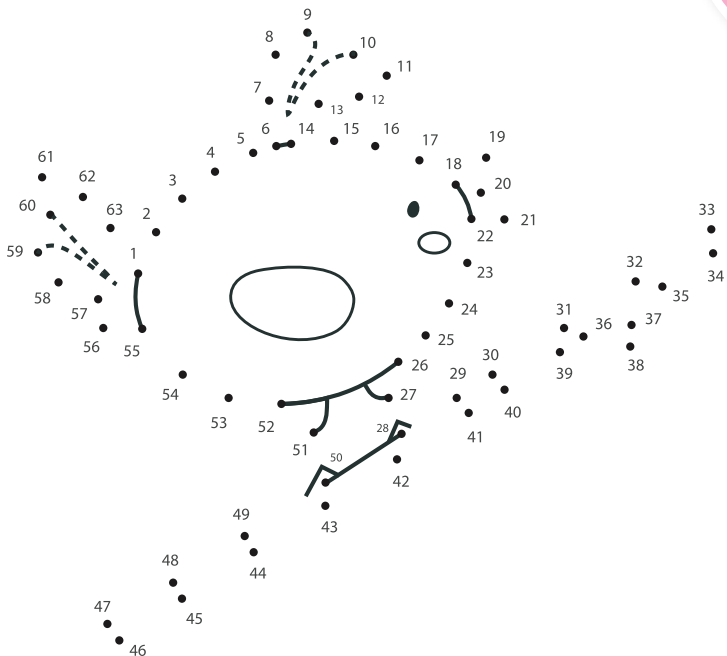

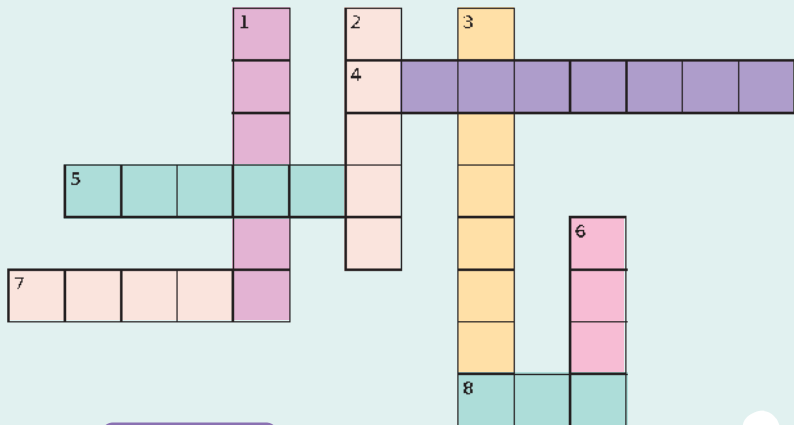
