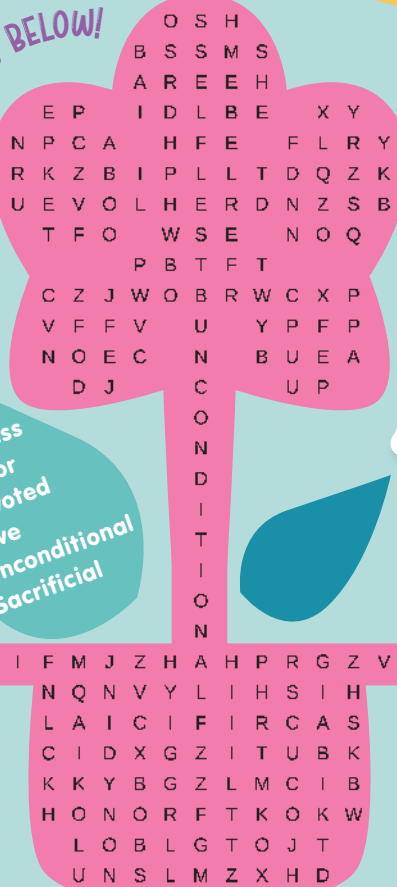
As Christians, we should never get our own wants satisfied.
